### Observations

I think that the children are finally ready to have observers come into the classroom. If you are interested in coming to observe, please let myself or Leah know and we will schedule a time.

When you come to observe there are some guidelines that we need you to follow. First of all, please enter the classroom as quietly as possible, remove your coat and shoes, and come into the main part of the classroom where we will have an observation chair waiting for you. During your observation time we ask that you interact with the children as little as possible. If a child approaches you to chat it is alright for you to remind them that you are just there to observe. Your stay will probably last between 20 and 30 minutes. When that time is over, please leave the class as quietly as you entered it. If you think of questions during your observation, please write them down and we would be happy to answer them after class or during your conference.
